Acrostic Poem Examples

An acrostic poem is a poem where certain letters in each line spell out a word or phrase. Typically, the first letters of each line are used to spell the message, but they can appear anywhere. A poem where the first letter of each line and the last letter of each line spell out words is called a double acrostic.

Abecedarian: Acrostic in which alphabets are spelled instead of words. Chaucer's poem "La Priere de Nostre Dame" is a good example of an abecedarian acrostic. Non- Standard: Non-standard acrostics do not use first or last letters to spell out a word. Instead, they emphasize letters in different places within the poem.

Definition of Acrostic Poems An acrostic poem is a poem where the first letters of each line spell out a word or phrase vertically that acts as the theme or message of the poem. Sometimes a word or phrase can also be found down the middle or end of the poem, but the most common is at the beginning.

Acrostic Definition. The word that is spelled out in an acrostic is called the acrostich. The acrostich typically bears a special meaning in relation to the content of the acrostic, such as revealing the name of the poem's subject or the name of its author. Acrostic poems may be written in meter or in free verse, with or without rhyme.

Definitions of acrostic. n. - A composition, usually in verse, in which the first or the last letters of the lines, or certain other letters, taken in order, form a name, word, phrase, or motto. n. - A Hebrew poem in which the lines or stanzas begin with the letters of the alphabet in regular order (as Psalm cxix.). See Abecedarian. n.

When children write acrostics, they will often use their own first name, or sometimes the first name of a friend. Usually, the first letter of each line is capitalized.
