USDA ERS

Food consumption in terms of the Dietary Guidelines for Americans' food groups is reported for all sources and the total U.S. population, as well as by food source, children age 2-19, and adults age 20 and older. Data on where food is obtained are used to divide food into 2 categories—at-home and away-from-home food.

Nursing Home (name)

1. Certified Nursing Assistants indicate the amount of each food and fluid item consumed at meals by marking the intake record provided with the resident's meal. 2. The completed intake records are tallied the following day by the Food and Hydration Aide (FHA) and trended on the Food and Fluid Intake Tracking form. 3.
